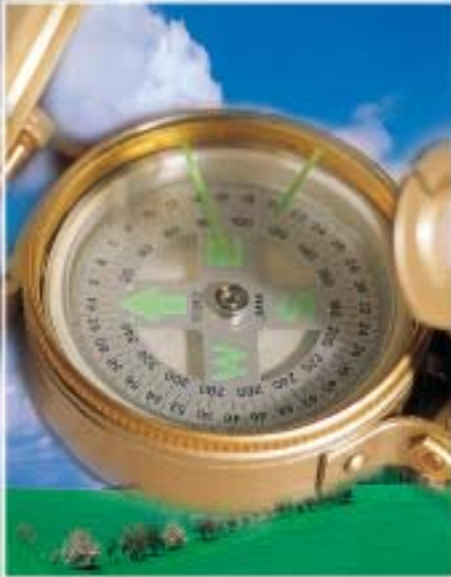


## Admission Criteria

## Treatment Philosophy

Located in the outskirts of Richmond, our Residential Treatment Program and Assessment and Diagnostic Services are committed to providing the highest quality care in the most cost-effective program available. We believe that providing adolescents with a safe, secure, and well-structured environment helps our residents learn to build trusting and healthy relationships with others.



## RTC Substance Abuse & Chemical Dependence Treatment Services

Hallmark's SA/CD treatment services are an incorporated part of the residential program. Services focus on the adolescent's past substance abuse or involvement, as well as future relapse prevention plans for sustaining drug- and tobacco-free living.

The Adolescent Residential Treatment Program offers three separate tracks to individualize treatment and tailor services: a **general process track**, a **substance abuse track**, and a **survivor's track**. Upon admission, residents are assessed and placed in the appropriate track, therefore attending therapeutic groups and activities to address his or her individual needs and treatment issues.

## Program Components

- Multi-disciplinary treatment approach providing individualized care
- Assigned psychiatrist and nursing coverage 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Individual, Group and Family therapies
- Therapeutic Groups: Grief/Loss Issues, Social Skills, Leisure Awareness, Anger Management; Moral Reasoning, and Independent Living Skills
- Geographically distant family therapy, if needed
- Comprehensive educational services licensed by the Virginia Department of Education
- Therapeutic recreation activities and community outings.

## Assessment and Diagnostic Services/Emergency Placement:

For children who do not have the necessary evaluations required to determine the most appropriate level of care. Our Assessment and Diagnostic Services can provide a secure facility in which to complete these evaluations for appropriate placement services.

Patients admitted to the A&D program receive:

- ~ Psychiatric evaluation
- ~ Psychological and psychosocial assessments
- ~ Nursing Assessment / complete health and physical
- ~ Educational Assessment



Patients may also receive Chemical Dependency, Nutritional and Survivor's Assessments if indicated.

*(A & D Services not covered by Medicaid.)*

Hallmark's Certified Substance Abuse Counselor meets monthly with the Aftercare and Multi-family Support Groups to provide guidance, information, and support to discharged adolescents and their families.
